## External bodies and regulators

- **Ofsted** inspects and regulates services providing education and skills for learners of all ages.
- **Ofqual** regulates qualifications, exams and tests in England.
- Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) a national framework to help people understand qualifications.
- Awarding organisations issues qualifications formally recognising learning outcomes (knowledge, skills and/or competencies of an individual) following an assessment procedure.

### Role of the Assessor

- To create a positive and safe climate/environment
- Assess against criteria
- To be unobtrusive
- Negotiate and communicate with the learners about the assessment
- Prepare appropriately.
- Explain simply and clearly the process
- To be empathetic and understanding about concerns or lack of understanding
- To assess in a systematic and trusted way
- To show no favouritism or pre-judgment
- To be fair
- NOT exercise authority

#### Role of the Internal Verifier (Internal Quality Assurer)

- Works within the recognised Centre
- Verifies assessment activity
- Supports and develops assessors and tutors
- Manages quality of delivery
- Has responsibility for liaison with the Awarding body through the External Verifier
- Leads and facilitates standardisation of delivery and assessment
- Ensures safe and correct practice
- Internally quality assures all assessment activity in accordance with agreed strategy
- Implements and checks adherence to centre policies

#### Role of the External Verifier (External Quality Assurer)

- Works for the awarding organisation
- Verifies activity and/or administrative systems
  - Direct claims
  - Ongoing monitoring
- Supports and develops assessors, tutors and the recognised centre
- Verifies quality of delivery
- Liaison with the recognised centre through the internal verifier and the course administrator
- Ensures safe and correct practice
- Implements and checks adherence to centre policies
